Orbxolotl Pattern



Difficulty: Beginner

Abbreviations

- mr – magic ring
- sc -single crochet
- hdc – half double crochet
- dc – double crochet
- tr – treble crochet
- pc – popcorn stitch
- ch - chain
- st - stitch
- sl st – slip stitch
- inc – increase crochet
- dec – decrease crochet
- fo – finish off
- c1 – color one
- c2 – color two
- () - repeat indicated number of times

Body (c1)

R1: sc 6 into a mr [6]

R2: (inc) x6 [12]

R3: (sc, inc) x6 [18]

R4: (sc, inc, sc) x6 [24]

R5: (sc 3, inc) x6 [30]

R6: (sc 2, inc, sc 2) x6 [36]

R7 – 8: sc around [36]

R9: sc 5, pc, sc 24, pc, sc 5 [36]

R10 – 12: sc around [36]

- add eyes between R5 and R6 4 stitches apart

- embroider mouth (I forgot to in the example image)

R13: (sc 2, dec, sc 2) x6 [30]

R14: sc 3, dec, pc, sc 2, dec, (sc 3, dec) x3, pc, sc2, dec [24]

R15: (sc, dec, sc) x6 [18]

R16: (sc, dec) x6

R17: (dec) x6



Tail

1. attach your yarn (c1) to a post in the middle of R13 on the back
2. ch 8
3. in 2nd ch from hook, sc
4. continue down the chain hdc 2, dc 2, tr 2
5. sl st to post above in R12



6. fo
7. attach your yarn

- (c2) to the post below the tail on R14
8. hdc around tail putting 3 in the tip
9. hdc around post tail is attached to in R12
10. hdc around posts above tail in R11 and R10
11. sl st around same post in R10
12. fo



Gills x2

1. attach your yarn (c2) to post in R8 2 st behind arm
2. ch 7
3. starting in 2nd ch from your hook, alternate dc and sl st down the chain ending with a sl st
4. sl st to post above in R7
5. ch 7
6. repeat step 3
7. sl st to post above in R6
8. ch 7
9. repeat step 3
10. sl st to same post in R6
11. fo



Repeat on other side
